CAP AND GOWN AND APPROPRIATE GRADUATION ATTIRE

If you still need to purchase a cap and gown, call <u>Herff-Jones</u> directly at 815-765-4743 between 10 am and 4 pm to do so. <u>Students will be expected to wear a cap and gown during the ceremony. Students will be expected to wear masks during the ceremony. We will be providing students with a Crystal <u>Lake South Class of 2021 mask, but students will be permitted to wear a mask of their choice.</u> <u>Students will not be permitted to decorate their cap.</u></u>

This is a formal graduation ceremony. Students should come dressed appropriately. Cords and stoles provided by the school are permitted to be worn at the graduation ceremony. These include NHS medals and French Honor Society cords. Students may also wear stoles representing the various branches of the military they are enlisting in. LAST DAY FOR SENIORS AND SENIOR BOOK/ CHROMEBOOK RETURN

Check Skyward Family Access to <u>be sure your student's account balance is ZERO</u>. All outstanding balances must be paid prior to Graduation. Monthly statements and now weekly statements have been emailed to all families with outstanding fees. Please contact Mrs. Gorman (ext. 3216, pgorman@d155.org) with any questions regarding fees.

Seniors must return all <u>textbooks</u> and class materials today. You will be required to pay for missing or damaged textbooks and materials. Please check with Mrs. Babick (ext. 3256, <u>lbabick@d155.org</u>), in the main office, for replacement costs. <u>Remote students</u> may come in to return their textbook and HOTSPOTS (if applicable) between 3-4 pm on Tuesday, May 11th. A make-up session will also be held on Wednesday, May 12th from 9-11 a.m. Early grads can stop by for tickets on May 12th from 9-11 a.m.

Seniors must return <u>HOTSPOTS</u> provided to them this past school year. The HOTSPOT, power cord and box must be returned in working order.

Remote students may come in to return their materials between 3-4 pm on Tuesday, May 11th. A make-up session will also be held on Wednesday, May 12th from 9-11 a.m.

At senior book return on May 11th, four Graduation Tickets will be issued to all students who have met all the above requirements. The ceremonies will be live-streamed. That link will be sent to you by the District Office.

If your student fails a course required for graduation, he or she will not be able to participate in our graduation ceremony. If this circumstance arises, you will be notified by the end of the day on Friday, May 14th.

There will NOT be a graduation rehearsal this year. Instead a video with instructions will be sent to seniors beforehand by the end of the day on Thursday, May 13. We are encouraging all students to watch this video so they understand how the ceremony will function on Saturday.
